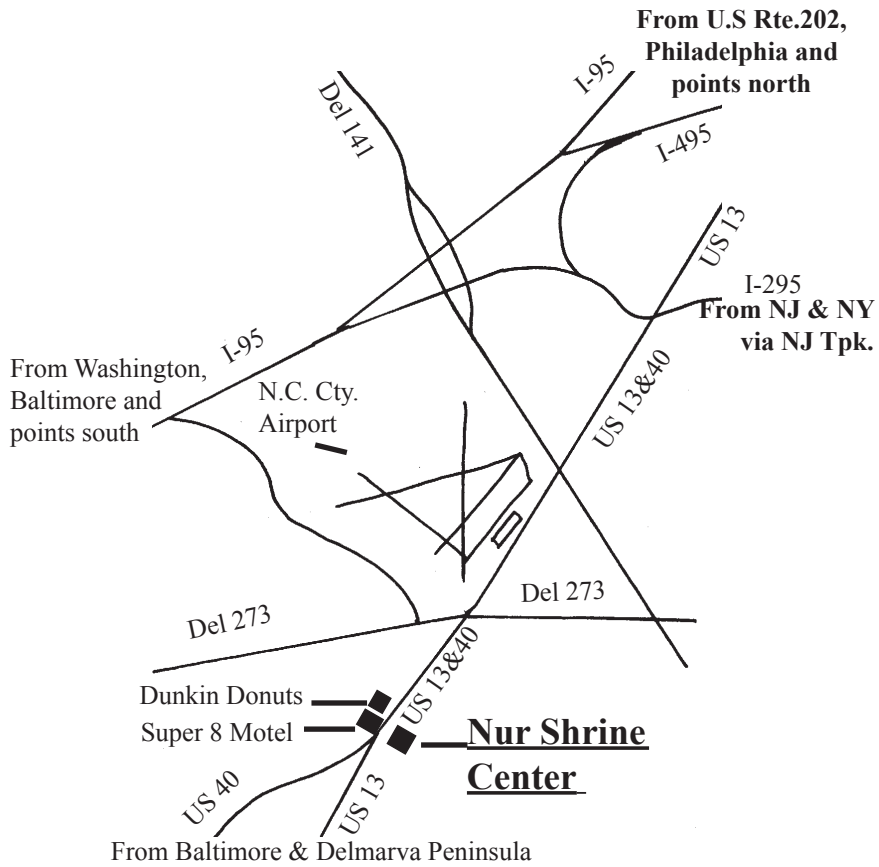


**NUR SHRINE CENTER LOCATION**



**Part A**

- Coming from I-95, I-495: Exit on Del. 141 south. (To New Castle)  
Turn south on US 13. Go to Part B.
- Coming south on US 13: Go to Part B.
- Coming north on US 13 or US 40: Travel north to junction of US 13 & 40.  
Nur Temple is just past intersection at right.
- Coming from NJ: Cross Del. Mem Bridge, take US 13 south. Go to Part B.
- Coming north or south on Del 273: Take US 13 south. Go to Part B.

**Part B**

Follow US 13 & 40 south 0.9 miles past intersection with Del. 273. Stay in left lane and make U-turn at last crossover before 13 & 40 split (just past Dunkin Donuts & Super 8 Motel). Nur Center is on right, opposite motel.

## This Year at DELPEX

### *100th Anniversary of the National Park Service*

2016 marks the 100th anniversary of the creation of the National Park Service. While our first national park was created in 1872, it was not until 1916 that a new entity was created under the Department of the Interior to manage operation of all the parks. In conjunction with that theme, there will be two souvenir commemorative cacheted covers with a thematic cancel available. They will be serviced by the on-site USPS show substation or available by mail. This year's show continues at last year's location, the Nur Shrine Center at 168 South DuPont Highway (U.S. Routes 13 & 40) in New Castle, DE19720.

Please see the back page for a map. Parking and admission are free. The dealer bourse has twenty-one tables, and we will have a U.S. Postal Service substation to sell new issues and service covers. As in the past, a Bid Board Silent Auction with over five hundred lots will be held. Bidding closes at 3:30 PM.

Exhibits on any subject are welcome, but especially welcome are those with a national park connection. Exhibitors may enter up to eight frames of sixteen pages each. A frame fee of \$5.00 per exhibitor applies, or \$2.00 per exhibit for juniors under age 18.

A separate form is required for each exhibit. Completed forms must be received by him by 3 weeks before the show date to ensure a listing in the program. Accepted exhibits with numbered pages must be in his hands by 10 days before the show. Those exhibitors who prefer to mount their own material must be at the exhibit hall by 8 AM April 23rd. Mailed exhibits require the prepayment of postage both ways.

The exhibits will be mounted between 7 AM and 10 AM on Saturday. We will make every reasonable effort to protect exhibits; no representations are made with respect to loss or damage. Exhibitors are advised to obtain their own insurance.

## DELPEX 2016 EXHIBITING RULES

1. DELPEX 2016 is accepting exhibits conforming to the DELPEX rules, which generally follow those for A.P.S. Display Class, which are intended to appeal to the general public. The exhibitor's effort will be judged against that standard. All exhibits will be judged using the DELPEX rules, which will be provided on request. Summarizing, the criteria are:

Story Content - 30%, Philatelic Content - 20%, Originality - 10%,  
Knowledge - 20%, Condition - 10%, and Presentation - 10%.

Photos, FDCs, cinderellas, etc., supporting the story may add viewer appeal. Please note on the entry form whether the exhibit is competitive or non-competitive.

2. This exhibition is open to all collectors regardless of philatelic affiliation who conform to these rules. A youth's entry form requires a parental or guardian's signature.

3. Each frame holds sixteen 8-1/2" x 11" pages. There is no rule as to how that space may be utilized at this show. If an unusual mounting is required, instructions must accompany the exhibit.

4. Judging will be done by a panel of local philatelists having no conflict of interest. Awards will be first, second and third place ribbons per the A.P.S. point system. Exhibits may be removed after 3 PM Saturday.
